Where are we now ?

The first stage of the project has just been completed. We have completed the presentation of the school situation in the partner countries and the analysis of the questionnaires.

A survey was carried out in the partnership countries : 300 teachers and 600 students : were involved and answered about twenty questions. The aim of this questionnaire was to determine their level of knowledge concerning the use of the Internet.

The main finding of this survey is, although young people use the Internet on a daily basis (on average more than 3 hours a day), their level of knowledge about how to search for information, about data protection and about the authenticity of information is largely insufficient.

For teachers, their personal and professional use varies according to their age but is still quite limited. We are now going to work on a guide that will allow us to prepare the third step, which is the creation of a curriculum and an interactive platform.

To conclude these two days of work, ISC had organised a visit to two establishments.

The whole team was welcomed by Mr Ethève, vice director of the Calypso school in Montreuil-Bellay, and by Mrs Gautier, vice director of the Saint-Louis institution in Saumur.

The partners took advantage of this seminar to discover the French school system and were able to measure the differences with their own country. The elected officials and school representatives appreciated the gifts brought by the Turkish delegation.

The next meeting will take place in Italy in early May 2022. On this occasion, we will keep you informed of the progress of the project.
